The Corry Area Intermediate School library displayed the Sherlock Holmes books all year long. Many students checked out the books and were excited to read them and share what they learned.



EXPLORE

Students EXPLORED the World of Sherlock Holmes by reading “The Man Who Never Lived Can Never Die” by Laura Sook Duncombe and watched the cartoon Sherlock Hound *The Adventures of the Blue Carbuncle*.

The teacher read “The Man Who Never Lived Can Never Die” by Laura Sook Duncombe to the students to introduce them to Sherlock Holmes. During each library class the smartboard had an ambience video of Sherlock Holmes’ living room in Victorian London. Students participated in a Breakout EDU escape room during library class.

The teacher read “The Adventures of the Blue Carbuncle” by Stephanie Baudet during read aloud time in library class. The students watched the cartoon Sherlock Hound *The Adventures of the Blue Carbuncle* and we compared and contrasted the book and the movie.

EXPERIENCE

Students EXPERIENCED the Canon by listening to the stories “The Red-Headed League” and “The Adventure of the Blue Carbuncle.”

The students participated in the play “THE RED-HEADED LEAGUE” *A Play Based on a Story by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle*, Adaptation by: © Marino C. Alvarez, 2007. They enjoyed being a part of the story and using voices for each character.

The students watched the cartoon Sherlock Hound *The Adventures of the Blue Carbuncle* and we compared and contrasted the book and the movie.

EXTEND

Students EXTENDED their understanding and appreciation of the great detective by reading copies of Sherlock's Spotlight.

Students enjoyed reading the newsletter together. Each group of students read the same edition and discussed it together. Then each group shared what they read with the whole class. Students especially liked doing the puzzles and games.
